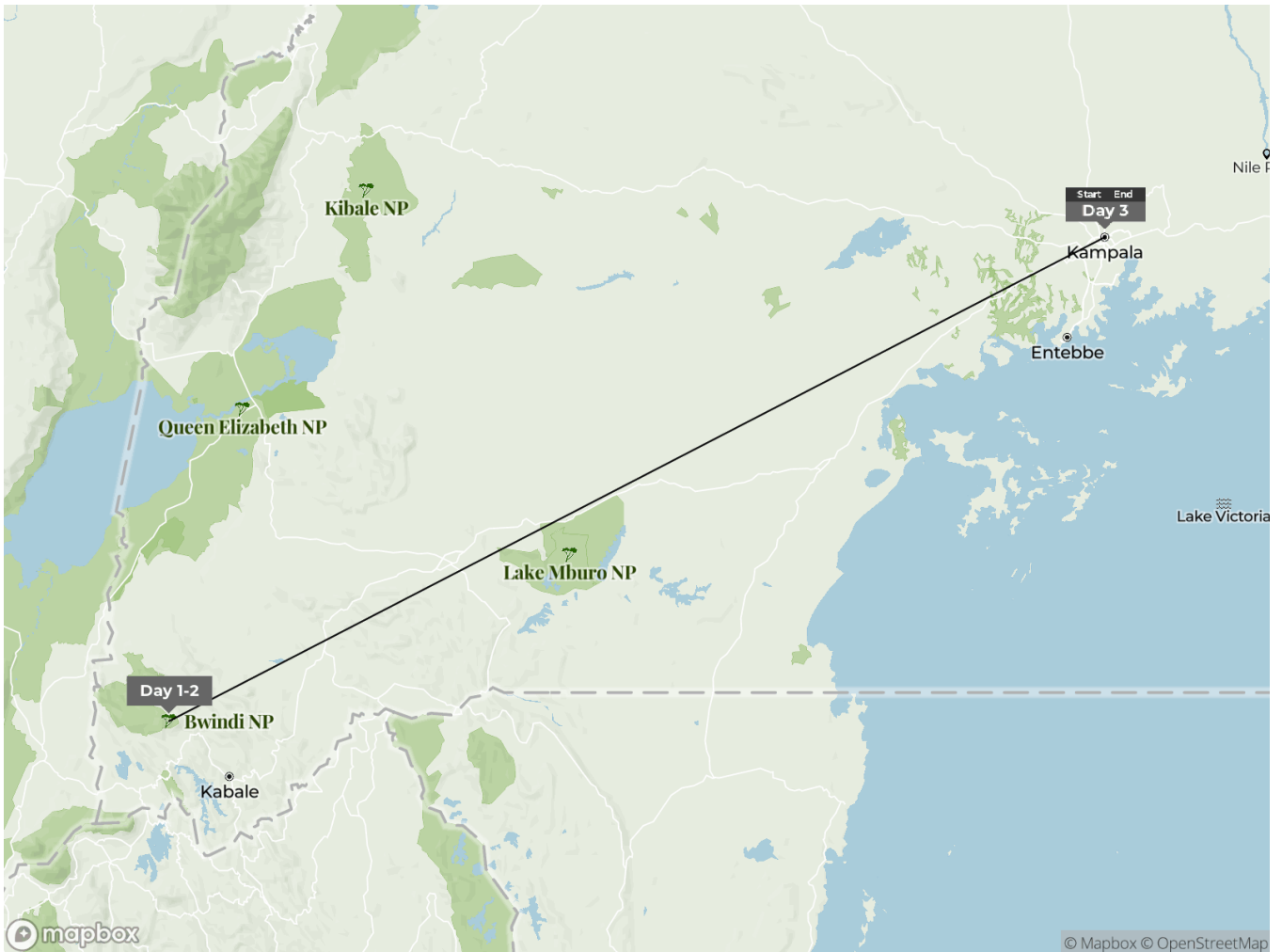

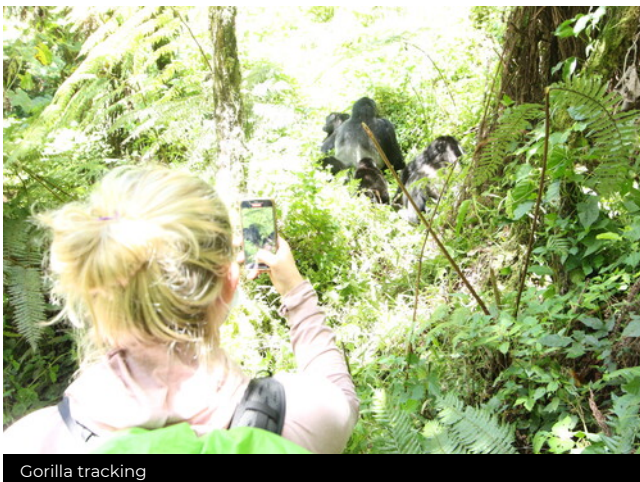

Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

While most of today's forests are no more than 12,000 years old, Bwindi's vegetation has been weaving itself into tangles over at least 25,000 years, in the process accumulating a lengthy species list. This includes 310 species of butterfly, 51 reptiles, 200 trees, 88 months, and an exceptional 120 types of mammal including 10 primates. The latter includes chimpanzee, L'Hoest's, red-tailed and blue monkey, black and white colobus, baboon, and Bwindi's most famous resident, the mountain gorilla.

Bwindi is a prime destination for birdwatchers. Its 350 species include seven which are IUCN red data listed and 90% of all Albertine rift endemics, species which are difficult or impossible to see in any other part of East Africa.

Activity Day 1

→ We shall arrange for the tour guide to meet with you in Kampala at 07:00 hours before starting the gorilla trek tour on your drive heading to the mountain gorillas' sanctuary of Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. En route, there is a local community popular for making local drums and crafts and a fruit market. Stopover, admire, and buy yourself souvenirs. Proceed to the Equator line taken as one beautiful scenery in Africa - the pathway of the sun and take photographs. The drive to the mountain gorilla sanctuary is over 7 hours from Entebbe or Kampala, most of the time on the smooth-surfaced road with about 45 minutes of dusty murrum. You could choose to fly to Bwindi if you don't feel like driving. One-way flights range from 280\$-360\$ pp.

Ichumbi is a very intimate lodge in the middle of the Bwindi forest. The rooms were amazingly nice and very private and quiet.

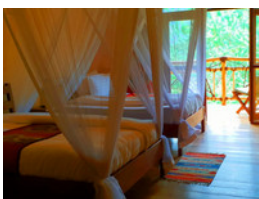
Fitted with a sun terrace, the units feature a flat-screen TV. A balcony with garden views is offered in each unit. Each room has a private bathroom with free toiletries.

Vegetarian, buffet, full English/Irish, continental, and American breakfast options are available each morning at the lodge.

Ichumbi Gorilla Lodge offers a terrace. For guests' convenience, the accommodation has a business centre. Guests can also relax in the shared lounge area. Advice on the best sites to visit in the area is offered at the 24-hour front desk.

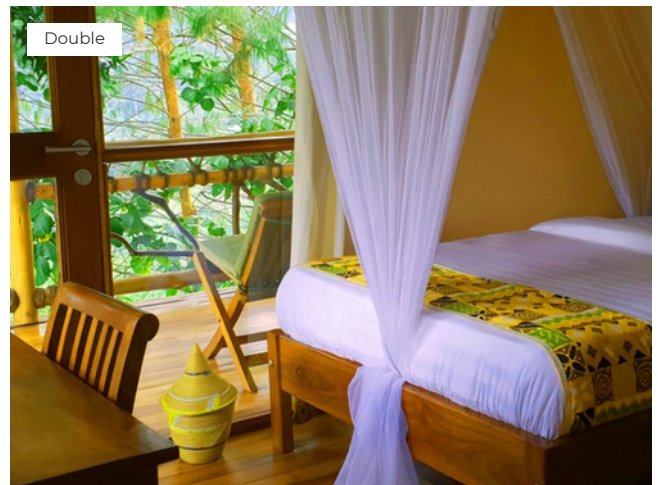
Activity Day 2

→ **Mountain Gorilla Trekking, Bwindi Impenetrable National Park**

The Big Day arrives! Enjoy a good breakfast to give you energy for the day ahead. A short transfer will take you to Park HQ where you will be allocated to your gorilla family, receive a briefing on the ecology of the animals, and meet your guides and porters (you can hire a porter for \$15). Then the trek begins. Expect to be walking for on average 3 hours in steep terrain before making contact with the gorillas. Then you have up to one hour to observe these amazing animals from a distance of 6 metres. When the magical hour is up, return through the forest to HQ and your lodge.

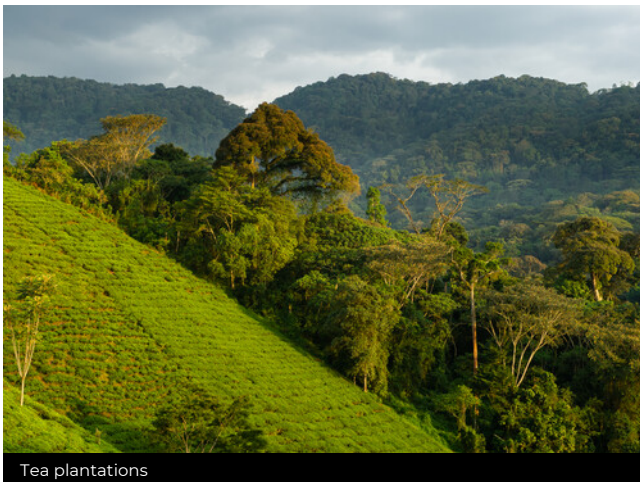

→ Transfer by Road, Bwindi Impenetrable National Park to Kampala

We check out from the camp/lodge early in the morning for a drive down the grassed and terraced escarpments of southwestern Uganda while taking in the breathtaking sights of the hills of the region dubbed 'the little Switzerland of Africa'.

This area is a highly fertile, mountainous region with steep-sided hills covered from top to bottom in neatly terraced cultivated rows. Not to miss as we traverse Mbarara are the impressive longhorn Ankole cattle. A remarkable highlight of this journey is the Equator line, and surely you will cross it as we have a brief stop here.

We will be in Entebbe in the evening before your flight back home.
