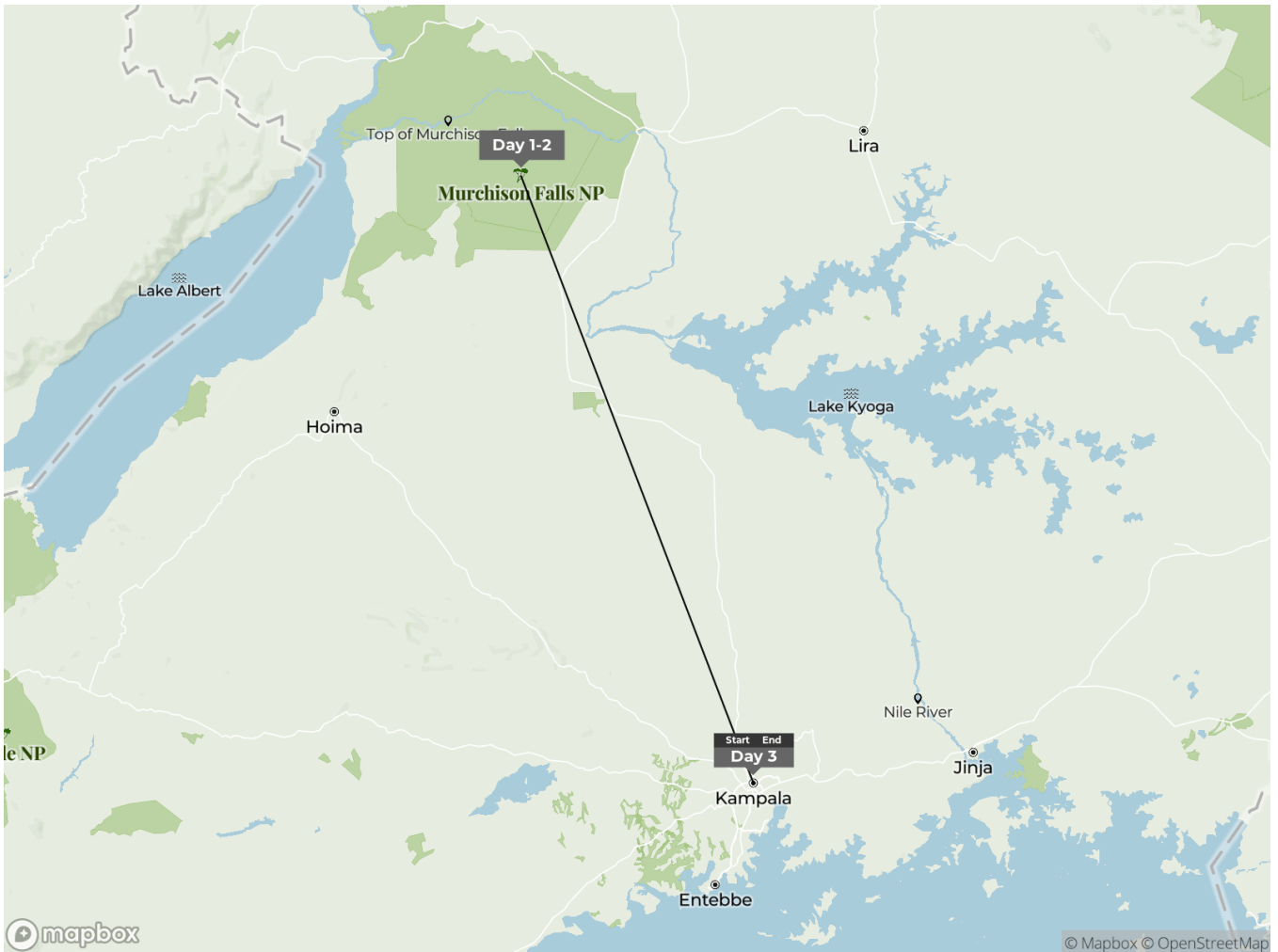

Murchison Falls National Park

Described as the most exciting thing to happen to the Nile along its 6,000km journey from Lake Victoria to the Mediterranean, the 43m-high Murchison Falls is also the centerpiece of Uganda's largest and oldest national park. Here you might encounter four of the Big Five (lion, leopard, elephant and buffalo), along with the world's largest population of the endangered Rothschild's giraffe, and several types of antelope and monkey. Particularly noteworthy among 550-odd recorded bird species are the hulking great shoebill and Abyssinian ground hornbill, and the beautifully marked and very localized white-crested turaco and red-headed lovebird.

Murchison Falls National Park

Activity Day 1

→ Rhino tracking, Ziwa Rhino and Wildlife Ranch

This afternoon you will join us for one of our favorite activities when we go rhino tracking. Come with us as we look for rhinos and track them through the bush.

After about 2 hours of driving, we go on a detour to the Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary the only place in Uganda where white rhinos can be found in the wild. For a better and more intimate experience, visitors to the rhino sanctuary can track them and get to about 6 meters from them. We shall be allocated a local ranger guide to lead us to the day's location of the rhinos. A short briefing about the instructions to follow on the trek to the rhinos shall follow before we start our walk to reach for them.

It won't take long before us reaching the rhinos. Although sometimes they wander off to far ranges, we could still drive for a bit to reach them faster. There are often sightings of other bigger wild mammals on this trek. It is not uncommon to encounter waterbucks, bushbucks, kobs, duikers, and sometimes leopards on this trek.

When you reach the rhinos, you will be allowed a maximum of 1 hour with them.

→ Visit and View the Top of Murchison Falls

We plan to have a stop at the top of the falls, the vantage place to view Murchison Falls closely from above. While at the top of Murchison Falls, you will see the entire Nile River, the longest river in the world, forcing itself through a 7-meter-wide gap and then furiously plunging 43 meters downwards. The sight is beyond description, and the memory of which will certainly stick with you for the rest of your life. No wonder many keep returning over and over again

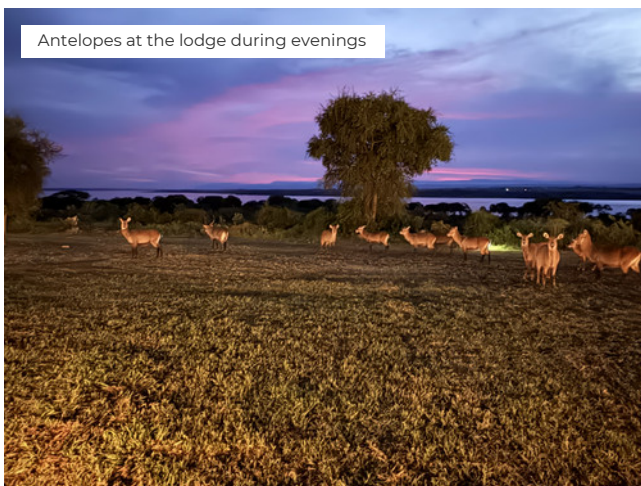

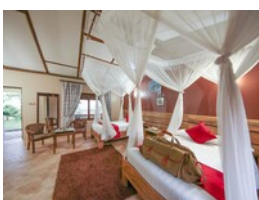
We will stay at Pakuba Safari Lodge, where you can enjoy views over a lushly vegetated stretch of the Albert Nile from the swimming pool and balcony. The lodge is located inside the park. Wildlife like hippos, elephants, warthogs, buffalo, and lions are often seen roaming the lodge grounds. It provides easy access to the national park's most reliably productive game-drive circuit.

**Activity Day 2**
→ Guided Game Drive - Murchison Falls National Park

In Murchison Falls National Park, your early morning game drive gets you close to the wildlife when they're most active, and the landscapes are at their most beautiful.

Seriously consider enduring an early morning start this morning to increase your chances of sighting the big cats in Murchison Falls National Park. The usual setting is for guests to depart from the lodge not later than 6:30 AM and then launch into the wilderness before the heat of the day. There is just so much to see in Murchison Falls National Park - hyenas, leopard, lions, giraffes, herds of elephants, buffaloes and many more. We allow for whole morning to be spent on covering most of the lucrative trucks in the park, combing out every thicket we expect to have wildlife in it. Enjoy and have all the fun!

→ Boat Trip - Murchison Falls National Park

We will then go for an afternoon boat cruise to the foot of Murchison Falls. This boat trip along the Nile is often cited as being the highlight of a trip to Murchison since it allows you to get up-close and personal with the animals. Along this stretch of the river, there are reported to be around 4,000 hippos in addition to some enormous Nile crocodiles. The birdlife is stunning with brightly colored kingfishers and bee-eaters darting along the riverbanks. If lucky, you may see the rare and prehistoric-looking shoebill, which is a cross between the dodo and a dinosaur. The boat takes you to the base of the falls which only adds to their impressiveness
