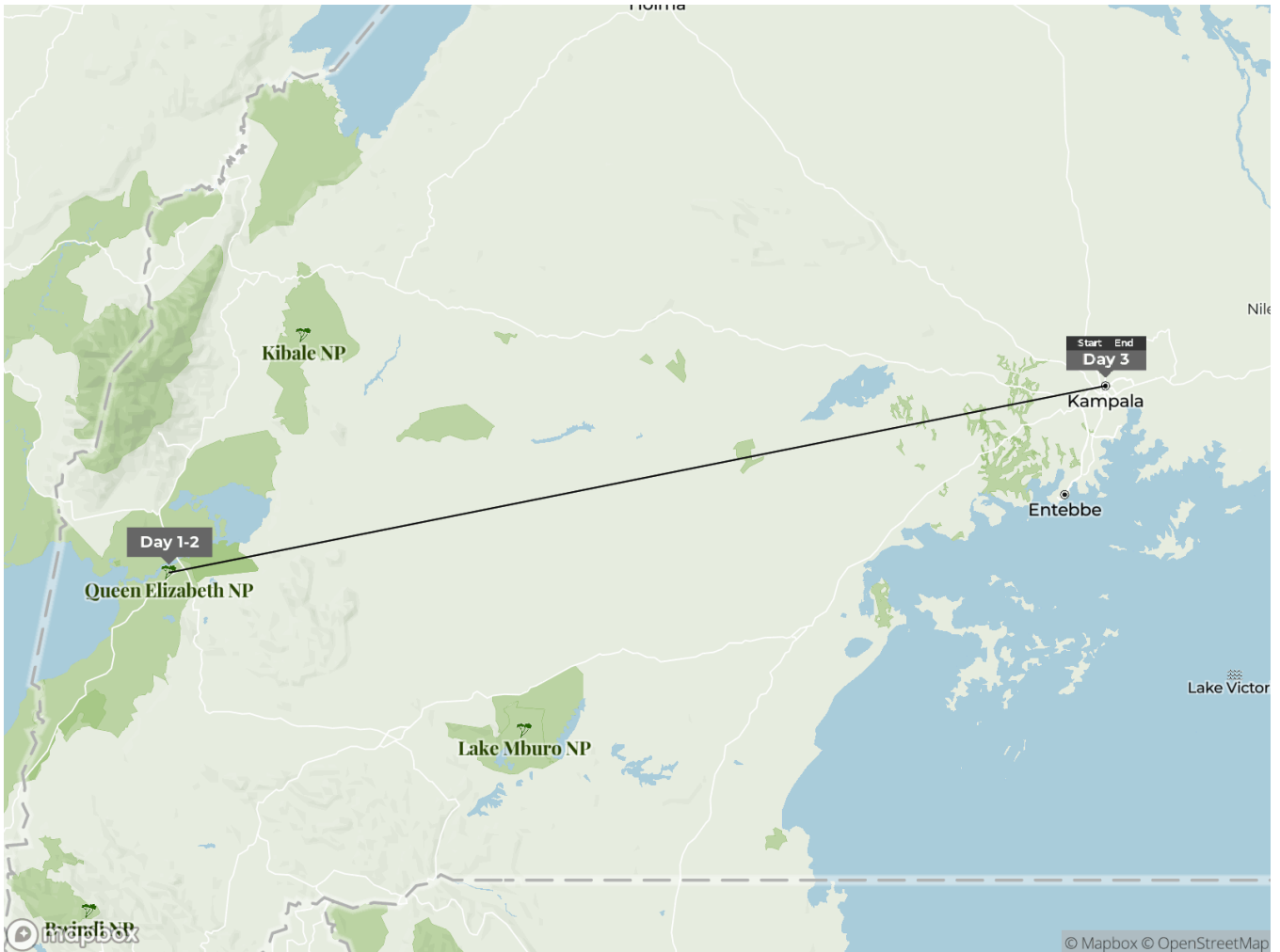

Explore Queen Elizabeth National Park, Uganda's best all-round safari destination. In addition to being home to four of the Big Five (lion, leopard, elephant, and buffalo), this biodiverse park is studded with wetlands that support an astonishing 5,000 hippos along with large flocks of flamingos, pelicans, and other aquatic birds. Weather permitting, the views of the glacial peaks of the Rwenzori, Africa's second-highest mountain (after Kilimanjaro), are also exceptional.

Activity Day 1

- We shall arrange for the tour guide to meet with you in Kampala at 07:00 hours before starting the safari.
En route, there is a local community popular for making local drums and crafts, and a fruit market.
Stopover, admire, and buy yourself souvenirs.
Proceed to the Equator line, taken as one beautiful scenery in Africa - the pathway of the sun and take photographs.
- On entering the park, we conduct a game drive in the northern sector of the park. Expect to encounter large herds of elephants, buffalo, antelopes, and vast populations of the Uganda Kob. We have an excellent chance to view just about every animal here at a very close range.

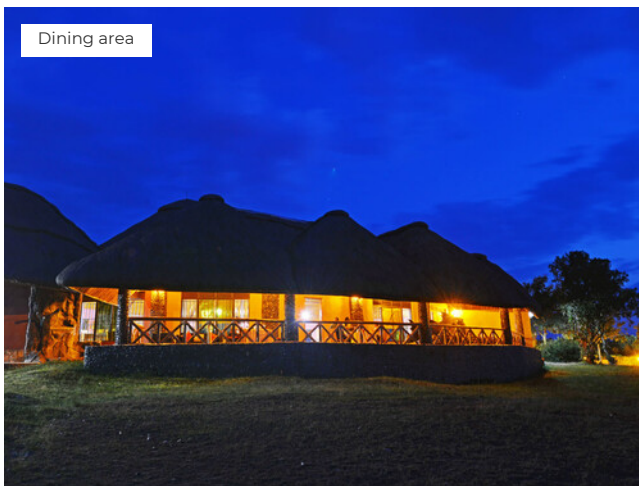

**Activity Day 2**

→ We set out early in the morning for a game drive in the northern part of the park on the Kasenyi Track in search of lions, elephants and solitary buffaloes. This is the best time for opportunities of viewing the cats in action owing to the vast population of Uganda kobs. We have an excellent chance to view just about every animal here at a very close range.

→ **Boat Trip, Kazinga Channel**

After, we'll enjoy a two-hour boat safari along the Kazinga Channel. This affords the opportunity to view wildlife up close: hippos huff and spray and buffalo linger in the shallows. The shores of the channel are also home to an array of birds including pink-backed pelicans, pied and malachite kingfishers, saddle-billed storks, and many others.

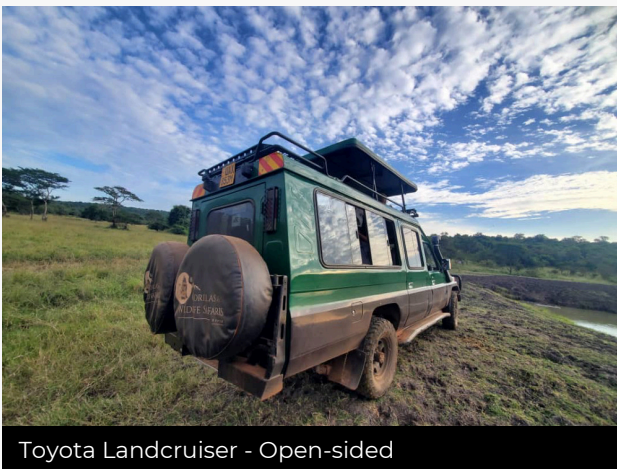
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Our vehicles
